1.1 Visas

Visa regulations and costs are subject to change and should always be double checked with your travel agent or Embassy of the UAE before traveling.

Note: Over staying your visa will result in fines and detentions.

There are three types of visas which can be obtained

1. Single Entry (One Month)
2. Single Entry (Three Months)
3. Multiple Entry (Six Months)

1- Visa application must be submitted to the Embassy's Consular Section at least TWO (2) Weeks Prior to Departure Date.

VISA FORM REQUIRMENTS:

- Original Visa form MUST be typed in and the Visa Form can be downloaded from the website.
- Photographs should be pasted with white background (NOT stapled or attached).
- Visa form with incomplete requirements will not be entertained.
- Visa application form must be signed by the applicant on the space assigned for his/her signature.
- The Particulars of Sponsor in UAE is a MUST requirement.
- Govt. Official should mention the Particulars of Sponsor as their Embassy or Consulate in UAE.

Ordinary passports will be charged for the visa according to the duration of stay in UAE i.e.:

- US \$ 200/- for (30) Days Single Entry.
- US \$ 400/- for (90) Days single entry.
- US \$ 800/- for (6) Months Multiple Entry.

Visa fees once deposited shall NOT BE refunded in case the applicant request is rejected/denied by the authorities in UAE.

For Six (6) months Multiple Entry visa the applicants are requested to provide the following:

- Note verbal from the Foreign Office/ Embassy explaining the reason of their frequent visits/travel to the lands of UAE.
- A Sponsorship letter from the sponsor in UAE, stating the importance of the applicant's visits to the UAE and that they have no objection in sponsoring them throughout their stay in the country.
- Note: All visitors should have a valid return ticket and a passport valid for a minimum period of three months.

For those who wish to obtain multiple entry visas it should be kept in view that the purpose of their frequent travel must not be for pleasure and transit.

- Tourism visa can be obtained from your travel agent.
- Transit visa can be obtained from the airport on arrival.

The Other types of visas are as under which can be obtained through the sponsor and the relevant authorities in the UAE:

Business

Exhibition/Festival/Conference

Resident

Employment

As a Pakistani, you need a visa to get into the UAE.

The types of visas available are :

Transit visa. 96 hours.

This can be obtained from :

1. Pre-apply through airline, travel agent, or UAE hotel before taking off.

Time between arrival and transit flight going out needs to be more than 8 hours.

Visa fees : AED 165 (Admin) and 165 (Form).

Passport needs to be valid for 6 months.

Time it takes to get visa : 1 to 2 weeks.

Urgent fees 100 AED : 2-3 days.

Marhaba service counter terminal 1 or Emirates hotels and visa counter in terminal 3

Transit visa application

Airline tickets with departure information on paper

Visit visa

Duration : Max 90 days.

Cost : AED 1,160

Not extendable.

Date of entry is within 2 months of visa issue.

Visa automatically cancelled on exit.

Single entry visa.

Reentry only permitted after 30 days of exit.

The bearer of the visit visa is not allowed to work in the UAE

Overstay charge of 200 AED for Day 1 and 200 AED per day from day2 onwards.

Tourist visa

Duration : Max 30 days.

Cost : AED 280

Extension : AED 710 for another 30 days.

Work Visa

Duration : 3 Years. Multiple entry

You can stay outside for up to 6 months. If you stay longer thenan NOC letter from the sponsor is required to return. This needs tobe provided to airline.

If the airline brings in any passenger without a proper visa orthe person cannot get a visa on arrival then the airline gets fined6000 AED per passenger of such type.

Cost : Minimum 8000 AED to sponsoring company.

Extendable up to age 65. After that you need a partner visa or aninvestor visa.

Special mission visa or service visa.

Duration : 16 days after arrival.

For temporary workers on probation.
